


# **CAMP LAKOTA PACKING LIST**

Because adventure doesn't pack itself.

 Please label **everything** – yes, even socks. Especially socks.

## **Clothing**

Pack for sun, sand, sweat, and comfort.

- 14 comfy T-shirts  
*\*1 plain white t-shirt for sing night\**
- 14 pairs of shorts
- 2-3 pairs of jeans (for cool nights + sing night!)  
*\*1 pair of classic blue jeans\**
- 3-4 sweatshirts
- 3 pairs of sweatpants
- 1 dress outfit for Banquet Night
- 20 pairs of socks (yes, twenty)
- 18 pairs of underwear (trust the process)
- 6 swimsuits (wet/dry rotation = pro move)
- 3 light pajamas + 3 warm pajamas
- Optional: a few "curfew/trip "fits"

## **Bath & Bedding Basics**

Because clean campers = happy cabins.


- 1 bathrobe (optional)
- 4-5 bath towels
- 3 beach towels
- 1 shower caddy
- Favorite toiletries  
*\*Pro tip: Be sure to pack toiletries they are familiar with, so they know what everything is and how to use it!\**

## **Bedding: (cot or twin XL)**

- 1 comforter
- 2 fitted sheets
- 2 flat sheets
- 2 pillowcases + 1 pillow
- 1 sleeping bag
- Optional: mattress pad/egg crate
- 1-2 Stuffed animals   
*\*Bring a little comfort from home!\**

## **Footwear for All Camp Terrain**

- 2 pairs of sneakers (run, hike, explore)
  - 1 pair of sandals or slides  
*\*popular pick: Crocs w/ jibbitz – (unofficial camp uniform, lots of kids have them)*
  - 1 pair of rain boots  
*\*if your camper will actually wear them!\**
  - 1 pair of boots with a heel  
*\*horseback riders, this one's for you *
  - 1 pair of shower shoes
  - Cleats  
*\*if they'll use them for sports & intercamps!\**

## Outerwear & Sun Protection

- 1 medium-weight jacket
  - 1 hooded raincoat
  - 1 baseball hat
  - Sunglasses
  - Swim goggles
  - Optional: Rashguards & sun shirts  
*\*great for extra UV protection ☀️*

## Day-to-Day Gear

- 1 Laundry Bag
  - Mesh sock wash bag  
*\*optional but great for keeping socks & underwear together in the wash\**
  - Flashlight + extra batteries
  - Battery-operated fan  
*\*No plug-in fans allowed\**
  - Watch + clock (battery-operated)  
*\*NO smart watches\**
  - 1-2 Water bottles – labeled and leak-proof  
*\*preferably one **without** a straw- they're easier to keep clean\**
  - Stationery + stamps + addresses (for actual letters! ✉️)  
*\*Pro tip: pre-addressed letters can be a big help!*
  - Pens, pencils, and 1 one-subject notebook
  - Books, quiet games for rest hour / early birds
  - Crazy Creek chair
  - 1 Sharpie/permanent marker
  - Extra name labels

## Luggage & Organization

- 1-2 soft trunks (36" x 17" x 17")  
MUST be clearly labeled
- 1 drawstring bag
- 1 backpack/duffel for overnight trips  
*\*Campers going into 7th grade & up\**

### Optional:



- Cubby cubes
  - Under-bed storage
  - 3 drawer set (plastic)
  - End-of-bed hanging shoe organizer
- 

## Camp Spirit Supplies

- Olympic gear (red + blue + green + yellow!)
  - Color War gear (gray + blue – game faces on!)
  - Theme + Special event items  
*\* Theme days list sent separately\**

## Optional Sports Equipment

*We have any equipment they might need, but we've found that kids enjoy playing with their own equipment more! So if they have it - label it and bring it!*

- Tennis racquet 
  - Pickleball Paddle
  - Baseball/softball glove 
  - Soccer socks & shin guards
  - Cleats
  - Anything else, they love to play!
